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RAPE OF BIBLICAL MORALITY

MORAL DECAY ... AND HOPE OF RESTORATION

"And whereas thou sawest the feet and toes, part of potters' clay, and part of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay. And as the toes of the feet were part of iron, and part of clay, so the kingdom shall be partly strong, and partly broken. And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay. And in the days these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdom, and it shall stand for ever" (Daniel 2:41-44).

Christians are in the midst of an ungodly generation. It is a generation that has no respect for Christians whatsoever. It is a generation that has embraced a lower standard of morality- and they call it "new morality". This "new" morality philosophy is subtle (or not so subtle) and it promotes the idea that marital infidelity is not wrong in this "liberal" age. What do I mean? In the past, a divorced person was considered a reproach in the eyes of his family and the society but today, he or she is thought to be fulfilling his or her sexual and psychological "freedom". I want to make it abundantly clear that I am strongly opposed to today's "easy" divorce syndrome (however, I feel that divorced people have my sympathy and I affirm the hope that the Lord is able to forgive and heal the agony of divorce). Clearly, the moral fabric of the society is eroding but there is something more alarming and shocking: Christians are tolerating this "new morality" and as such, allowing some of these adulterated values to invade the church. Instead of allowing the Word of God to be the absolute yardstick for establishing moral standards, we entertain a softer and more liberal moral philosophy (such as allowing remarriage in the church for an individual who has a living former spouse). There is something else that I find to be even more disturbing and it is this: I am sick and disgusted whenever I learn of churches that are pondering and contemplating whether or not to ordain homosexuals in the ministry. I realize that the homosexuals might argue that they are such by virtue of birth. I do not think so- as the Word of God bears this out (read Romans 1:18-32, Mark 7:21-22, James 1:13-16, Deuteronomy 23:18 and Revelation 22:15).

HATE SIN BUT LOVE THE SINNER

Now, in the event that you are a homosexual and you read this message, I have good news for you: I want to proclaim that you can be delivered and liberated from the bondage of homosexuality through the power of God. You need to come to Jesus Christ, accept the sacrifice He paid on the cross of Calvary and allow His precious shed blood to cleanse you.

Listen to these verses of Scripture:

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life" (John 3:16);

"And Jesus answering said unto them, They that are whole need not a physician: but they that are sick. I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance" (Luke 5:31-32);

"Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light" (Matthew 11:28-30);

"And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely" (Revelation 22:17);

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation" (Romans 10:9-10).

However, I want to quickly add that you must forsake and renounce your former sinful ways (read Revelation 22:15, 2 Peter 2:20-22, 1 Corinthians 6:9-11).

Yes, Jesus loves and cares for you and there is hope for you- why don't you come to Jesus today?

Please pray this prayer and do mean it with all of your heart:

"Dear Lord Jesus, I now recognize that I am a sinner and I am in need of salvation. I accept the sacrifice You paid for me on the cross of Calvary and I allow Your precious shed blood to cleanse me. I now surrender myself to You and invite You to be my Lord and Saviour. Please come into my heart. Take full control of my life and help me live and serve You from this moment forward. I ask in the name of Jesus. Amen."
